Reorganization of the Board will take place at the first regular meeting in January in accordance with Indiana Code 20-26-4-1(b). This statute requires the governing body of each school corporation shall organize by electing:

- (1) a president;
- (2) a vice president; and
- (3) a secretary;

each of whom is a different member, not more than fifteen (15) days after the commencement date of the members' terms of office.

Dr. Kegley will open the floor for nominations. The district traditionally has had a slate of officers recommended for nomination. A slate would include a president, vice president, and secretary. Nominations do not require a second. When there appear to be no further nominations, Dr. Kegley will ask for a motion to close nominations. If there is only one slate nominated, the slate will be declared elected. If there are multiple candidate slates, Dr. Kegley will ask for board members to vote. The gavel will be turned over to the president to run the remainder of the meeting.

Indiana Code 20-26-4-1(c) requires the governing body shall, at the time that officers are elected, appoint a treasurer of the governing body and of the school corporation who is a person, other than the superintendent of schools, who is not a member of the governing body. The treasurer may, with the approval of the governing body, appoint a deputy who must be a person, other than the superintendent of schools, who is not a member of the governing body and who has the same powers and duties as the treasurer, or lesser duties as provided by the governing body by rule.

Indiana Code 20-26-4-1 (d) stipulates that the treasurer is the official custodian of all funds of the school corporation and is responsible for the proper safeguarding and accounting for the funds. The treasurer shall:

(1) issue a receipt for money received by the treasurer;

(2) deposit money described in subdivision (1) in accordance with the laws governing the deposit of public funds; and

(3) issue all warrants in payment of expenses lawfully incurred on behalf of the school corporation. However, except as otherwise provided by law, warrants described in this subdivision must be issued only after proper allowance or approval by the governing body. The governing body may not require an allowance or approval for amounts lawfully due in payment of indebtedness or payments due the state, the United States government, or agencies and instrumentalities of the state or the United States government.

A verification, other than a properly itemized invoice, may not be required for any claim. A claim is sufficient as to form if the bill or statement for the claim has printed or stamped on the face of the bill or statement a verification of the bill or statement in language approved by the state board of accounts.

(e) Notwithstanding subsection (d), a treasurer may transact school corporation financial business with a financial institution or a public retirement fund through the use of electronic funds transfer. The treasurer must provide adequate documentation to the governing body of transfers made under this subsection. This subsection applies only to agreements for joint investment of money under IC 5-13-9 and to payments to the Indiana public retirement system for:

(1) the Indiana state teachers' retirement fund; or

(2) the public employees' retirement fund;

from participating employers.

(f) Except as provided in IC 5-11, a treasurer is not personally liable for an act or omission occurring in connection with the performance of the duties set forth in this section, unless the act or omission constitutes gross negligence or an intentional disregard of the treasurer's duties.

In accordance with Indiana Code 20-26-4-1(c), Dr. Kegley recommends that Katy Dowling, Chief Financial Officer, be duly appointed as Corporation Treasurer and Stephanie Madison, Director of Business, be duly appointed as Deputy Treasurer.

HSE Facilities was given permission to issue a Request for Proposals seeking Construction Manager as Constructor (CMC) services for the Fall Creek Intermediate Renovation Project at the August 9, 2023, School Board meeting. HSE received eight proposals on September 22, 2023, from the following contractors: CORE Construction, Garmong Construction, Hagerman Inc., Meyer-Najem Construction, Patterson Horth, Inc., Pepper Construction, Skender, and The Skillman Corporation.

The Evaluation Committee met on October 11 and October 18, 2023, to review responses. Based on the scores from the rubric and conversations with the Evaluation Committee members, it was determined that Hagerman, Inc., Patterson Horth, and The Skillman Corporation would be invited to return for in-person interviews.

On December 19, 2023, the Evaluation Committee interviewed these three firms as prospective CMC's to renovate Fall Creek Intermediate School for Hamilton Southeastern Schools. At the conclusion of the presentations and interviews, the Committee held a discussion and voted to recommend awarding the contract to The Skillman Corporation. Therefore, we are asking the School Board to approve entering into a contract with The Skillman Corporation as the CMC for this project. Once approved, preconstruction work will start immediately.
